ENJOY—after all, NITE is all about getting together and having fun with our horses.


FOXTON is one of those nice little towns that we mostly drive through on the way to somewhere else -usually Wellington.

Foxton Racecourse is on the northern outskirts of town . Some of the racecourse buildings are looking a bit tired and old , but the showers and loos were modernised and clean . Our venue was right beside the course , but separate from it -and well setup as a horse competition venue , with ample yards and facilities, including covered yards.





This year, there were 13 teams from 8 clubs. They came from Coastal (Taranaki –2 teams) and Twin City (Hawkes Bay– 1 team) down to Wellington.

Hosts Kapiti fielded 3 teams , 2 teams each came from nearby Oroua and Te Marua . Wanganui , Manawatu (Saddle Up) and Le Trec (Wellington)each had 1 team .

RIDING CLUB MOUNT

This obstacle course phase is compulsory at NITE. This year there was the option for ALL team members to ride, if they wished —with the best 4 scores to count. The course looked deceptively straightforward. It was good to see a course where riders could show how well they could complete an obstacle, though the guinea pig riders from a local Working Equitation Group made it look far too easy. They showed us a quite nifty way to negotiate a rope gate as a pair together—and several rider pairs choose to do it their way (as in photo right). Riding the course in pairs rewarded good teamwork, but I was surprised that many seemed to struggle with riding a good canter figure of 8.








▲ Oroua Mumbai Dream Factory set the tone and the standard—they rode first and came in 2nd with a really creative theme and stunning costumes

For many at NITE the Quadrille is the star phase.


Most team practise / prep is about the quadrille, and several teams gave a polished display with a clever theme.

These are my personal notes - intended as impartial comment, not criticism— I KNOW how much work it takes to put a quadrille together.

- -gold stencils look good on any colour horse . Several teams custom made and very effectively used stencils on horse rumps.
- -1 amazing piece of music can work well . Some teams used several pieces of music that fit their theme well .Take care that the music doesn`t sound "bitsy".
- some teams had a simple, effective and clever theme and costumes and musicthis worked well for them, and was reflected in the results.
- -Spectators thoroughly enjoyed ALL the quadrilles—comments were-awesome, impressive, incredible, cute.
- -How many colours of pinto are there ? 1 team had 4 broken coloured horses—all a different colour !!! They rode Pintaloosa, Buckskin, Chestnut and Grey Pintos.
- Thoroughbreds CAN DO ANYTHING—Sprinter of the Year START WONDERING won 11 races & \$700k. He was in a Coastal team and jumped with his friends !!!

TOP SCORE SHOW JUMPING

The Saturday night get together started with drinks & nibbles (thanks to NZRC Committee) - then a Burger Dinner was enjoyed by riders , supporters and organisers .

Nice to have such a large hall to use —plenty of room for all .

Sunday was the day for jumping—with the Showjumping competition a different choice of phase -Top Score Show Jumping, with ALL NITE combinations able to have a go if they wished. The best 4 scores for each team counted. This was popular initiative, with 7 teams starting 5 or 6 riders. Interestingly, the 5 top scoring teams all fielded 5 riders in this phase.

In Top Score, riders kept jumping until their 90 seconds was up. Each rider chose their own course out of 12 jumps of varying height and difficulty – with points to match. Each jump could be jumped twice only—and from either direction.

Courses ridden, jumps cleared and scores varied hugely, with team members urging their friends on at each jump.

Oroua Mumbai Dream Factory went first and just outscored Wanganui on the right.


