North Island Teams Event 2026 – Conditions of entry

- 1. Please read all Health & Safety Rules at venue these will be on display at events office.
- 2. All clubs must be financially affiliated to NZRC to enter this event
- 3. Riders must be 17 years of age or older on the 9th Jan 2026 and must be a financial member of their club. Horses must be 4 years of age or older.
- 4. Horse / rider combinations who have competed in the past two years HIGHER than Level 3 Dressage, ESNZ 1.10m show jumping and ESNZ CN1*1.05 Horse Trials may NOT compete in this event.
- 5. A horse may only be competed by ONE rider for the duration of the competition.
- 6. Teams consists of a minimum of 4 riders to a maximum of 6 riders
- 7. The venue will be available for you to arrive on Friday 9th January and leave on Sunday 11th or Monday 12th January. If you wish to arrive earlier please email letrecnz@outlook.com
- 8. This event is run under NZRC rules for competitors and entry implies acceptance of these rules. For further information please go to www.nzridingclubsbridleways.nz and click on 'Library' for the most current (August 2024) competition rule book to download rules.
- 9. A current yellow tagged safety approved equestrian helmet must be worn at all times whilst mounted as per venue conditions. Hat and Body Protector tagging will be available on the Friday if you have not managed to get your items tagged prior to event
- 10. Body protectors are compulsory for the Team XC phase and also recommended for all jumping events. This is a condition of using the Clareville XC course and these must be the current standard; So either BETA EN13158 2009 or later and ASTM F1937
- 11. Halter numbers must be worn in yards at all times and on the bridle or saddle 'D' ring during ridden phases. These will be provided and must be returned at the end of event.
- 12. Teams must provide their own XC bibs (numbers 1-6) as these will be worn in all phases except turnout and Quadrille. Riders must remain the same number for all phases.
- 13. Medical armbands are advised if you have any medical conditions.
- 14. DOGS are permitted but MUST be kept on a lead at ALL times and NOT left alone or unsupervised -this is a venue requirement. So, if you are riding you must have someone to look after your dog, otherwise please do not bring them. Riders of any unsupervised / offleash, out of control or disruptive dogs will be eliminated and asked to leave venue
- 15. Stallions are not permitted at this event or venue
- 16. First aid is based at event office and ANY riders who have a fall must be cleared before proceeding to their next phase. Vet and farrier details will be posted at the event office.
- 17. Muck piles for dung from the yards are provided so please use them. All yards must be cleared of dung, hay and leftover feed prior to vacating. Failure to comply incurs a cleaning fee of \$30 per yard. We recommend you take a photo of yard when you leave as proof.
- 18. Camping and yarding will be allocated and displayed at the event office. All yards are uncovered and likely grazed out so please bring plenty of hay, sun and rain protection. Please ensure your camping area is left clean and tidy and take ALL of your rubbish home
- 19. A Team briefing will be held on Friday evening at approximately 5.00pm. The Saturday dinner and entertainment will be held from 6.30pm
- 20. Please report any damage/breakages to yards to the event secretary at the event office at the earliest possibility.
- 21. Please return NITE trophies newly engraved and polished to the event office on arrival.
